- ECOWAS Commission, UEMOA Commission and West African member states' capacities in the framework of the existing regional integration process and EPAs are reinforced, Furthermore, the participation of NSAs in regional integration is enhanced;
- 4 Competitiveness of productive sectors is enhanced.

#### Planned activities to reach results:

- Completion of an ECOWAS Free Trade Area, Support to ECOWAS compensation mechanism in order to assist Member states in absorbing the fiscal losses of the free trade area, support to the implementation of the CET, training and modernization of national customs, support to the development of the region's trade policy, support to the implementation of a trade surveillance mechanism, support to the free movement of persons, services and capital,
- Development of a multilateral surveillance system within West Africa, development of regional statistical capacities,
- 3 Strengthening of the institutional capacity of UEMOA and ECOWAS and of the coordination between the regional organizations; enhancement of the participation of NSAs in major issues of regional integration,
- Support to competitiveness and TBT and SPS measures, harmonization of business law, promotion of harmonized regional sector policies including agriculture, livestock and fisheries.
